The hardest thing to do for anyone is to rely on others for assistance. Making the call to 911 for assistance is the most important and timely thing you can do for someone as soon as you identify a problem. The dispatcher on the other end of the phone can help gather information and provide it to us prior to arriving on the scene to enhance our treatment during your time of need. You are the first link in the chain of survival and your efforts can make the difference.

If you call 911 remember the following helpful points:

#### Things to do:

- Your name and phone number
- · What is the address of the incident?
- What is the issue or problem being reported?
- Listen carefully and perform the steps which the dispatcher instructs you

#### Things not to do:

- Don't hang up the phone until the dispatcher tells you to or help arrives
- · Don't leave the scene until help arrives
